

WORKING IN THE ARTS

Jobs in the arts fall into 2 basic categories: performing arts and visual arts. Museums and art galleries usually hire those with background and skills in the visual arts. Places that entertain (e.g. theme parks, jazz clubs, cruise ships) are good choices for those with talent in the performing arts. Some employers such as a performing arts center or arts education program may hire in both areas.

VISUAL ARTS:

Design plus background in journalism can lead to careers in magazine design. Computer knowledge combined with design can create careers in graphic design, web design, and multimedia. Design plus manufacturing knowledge suggests industrial or package design. Design plus retail can point to the field of visual merchandising. Love of theatre plus design can lead to set design or costume design. Finally, design plus business opens up possibilities in advertising agencies, interior design firms and design/marketing agencies.

PERFORMING ARTS:

There are more than one thousand performing arts related venues and services in the SF Bay Area. They include theatres and arenas, performance centers operated by cities or colleges, businesses that book entertainment, stores that sell theatrical or musical supplies, ballet, theater, and opera companies, symphonies and concert halls.
